The AJJ Scholarship Fund was established in 2002 to honor Art Jones, a 1982 Hampton Bays alumnus who tragically lost his life in the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001. The award was conceived by a group of Art's friends as a way of keeping his memory alive in the hearts and minds of all who knew and loved him. After graduating, Art attended Hamilton College on a basketball scholarship and ultimately worked at Carr Futures in the World Trade Center. **The AJJ Scholarship is presented to outstanding graduating seniors from Hampton Bays.** The criteria for selection includes, but is not limited to:

- Evidence of active community service and extra-curricular involvement;
- Academic success, defined as the "Honor Roll," with at least an 88 cumulative GPA;
- Athletic involvement all four years of school, with at least one year on a Varsity team at Hampton Bays High School;
- Completion of an essay at school;
- Participation in an interview with the Scholarship Committee;
- Financial need may be taken into account;
